MINISTRY NOTES

Foreign Missions Update

The church continues to support four children at the Love A Child mission in Haiti and they are very grateful for our support. Two of the original children moved away and were replaced with children from the Love A Child orphanage, Stefano and Rebecca. The children's home houses more than 70 abandoned and orphaned children in the care of Bobby and Sherry Burnette. The Burnettes have built schools, churches, a Jesus Healing Center, Malnutrition Center and a Birthing Center where women can deliver their babies safely. The couple also provide Mobile Medical Clinics as well as disaster relief and sustainability outreaches among many other things while facing many dangers daily as they travel the countyside feeding the poor. Gangs still control most of the country making it impossible for the people to move freely without being killed. The Lord led the Burnette's to hire some of the gang members for protection giving them the ability to move more freely to feed the poor and rescue abandoned children. During the earthquake we were able to send \$1,000 and an additional \$1,000 at the end of the year in addition to the support of the 4 children. Our dollars go a long way in Haiti - \$16 provides 432 meals, \$48 - 1, 296 meals, \$120

- 3,240 meals.

The earthquake was devastating and many people are still homeless either living outside in the elements though some were fortunate enough to receive a tent supplied by Love A Child which is still traveling around the island to find people who were affected by the quake and feeding children and their families in the villages. Their newest project is to build homes for the earthquake victims.

The Missions Team would like to thank everyone for their support through COVID and as we continue to serve. As we bless those less fortunate than ourselves, we in turn are blessed. Matthew 22:39 tells us to love our neighbours as we love ourselves. Who is your neighbor?
